2.	Minute of meeting held 18 March 2025:

3.	Matters Arising	
	- It was agreed that Elgin would host the first round of the Senior T20 Cup on 31st May.	
	- Mike spoke about the recent Captain's Meeting which was hosted by Cricket Scotland, however, it mainly covered issues that NoSCA don't have. Adam did arrange a follow up meeting with the Captains, but this was not well attended. Some feedback has been given which will be taken on board. Mike Fox stated that their captain had not received the details regarding the follow up meeting and wondered whether his details had been taken down incorrectly.	
	- There has been no interest in the vacant roles and so the Executive Committee will need to discuss how to progress. Munro mentioned that generally, clubs have a good relationship with local media sources and promote themselves through those channels.	
	- Adam has agreed to be the Disciplinary Officer, taking over from Andy Ballantyne.	
	- Ball orders have all been placed and those playing in coloured kit has been confirmed. Ronan advised that Fort Augustus have just received sponsorship and will be playing in coloured kit from mid-June.	
	- A query was raised regarding clubs changing from their initial decisions and whether this should happen. It was agreed that as it was only one club who had received sponsorship, we should be flexible and give the club they are playing notice that they will be in coloured kit as this will affect the colour of ball being used.	
	It was noted that NoSCA should have a small number of extra pink balls available.	
	- Mike advised that as Chris Blake has stepped down from his position within Cricket Scotland, there is a vacancy. Should anyone be interested in vacancy, please contact Mike.	ALL
4.	Playing Conditions	
	As Adam couldn't make the meeting, Mike gave an update following on from the feedback received, we should be moving forward this year and be aware of the opinions from the Captains. The feedback given relates to Senior Cricket and support is for the following:	
	- Wide lines in	
	- Leg side wides	
	- Short pitch bowling – 2 per over	
	- Playing hours – this is for the Captains and umpires to decide prior to the game starting along	

	- 30 yard circle – however, this may impact smaller grounds	
	- there should be no complications with power play	
	- it was agreed not to allow clubs to share players	
	In the Development League, it was agreed to keep to 40 overs and for Captains and umpires, if in attendance, to decide on hours should the weather be an issue.	
	There were a couple of queries in regards to boundary distance and the minimum number of overs, Mike will check with Adam and James Lean for them to clarify.	MD
